As stated in KRS 67.705 (1)

KRS 67.705 (1) ...If a vacancy occurs in the office of the county judge/executive, the remaining members of fiscal court shall elect one (1) of their members to serve as temporary county judge/executive until the Governor fills the vacancy in the office, notwithstanding the provisions of KRS 61.080(2) to the contrary.

On a motion made by Joe Bentley duly seconded by Paul B. Swearingen with Paul B. Swearingen voting yes to **adjourn** the meeting.
