AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE LEWIS COUNTY FISCAL COURT, HELD AT THE COURTHOUSE IN VANCEBURG, KENTUCKY AT 6:00 P.M., WITH THE HONORABLE THOMAS MASSIE PRESIDING AND WITH THE FOLLOWING MAGISTRATES IN ATTENDANCE: ESQ. MILT STANFIELD, ESQ. PAUL B. SWEARINGEN AND ESQ. JOE BENTLEY BEING ABSENT.
